

Eligibility Criteria

Admission Criteria

Services are provided to children ages 2 to 17, but younger or older people can be served if the payer or insurance approves. Our clinic specializes in young children. Services are primarily clinic-based. Payment for services may be by private pay, various insurance plans which cover services, or some special funding through local MHMR agencies or Medicaid waiver programs. Medicaid has begun to cover a few children for Applied Behavior Analysis, please contact us to make a Medicaid or managed Medicaid special request.

Discharge Criteria

Clients are discharged when all goals have been met and the client is ready to move on to a less intensive program. For young children, this is usually when the child is ready for a school program. However, child may benefit from lesser hours of our program in combination with the school attendance.

Transition Criteria

N/A. However, records may be shared with a new program or school, day care, etc. with written approval of the parent or guardian.

Readmission Criteria

Any client who demonstrates an ongoing need for behavioral support may be readmitted to the program.

Exclusionary or Ineligibility Criteria

This may be assessed on a case by case basis.
