What is ABA?

Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is a research-based scientific discipline that has shown to be the most effective intervention for individuals with Autism and Developmental Disabilities. ABA is not a recipe that can be applied the same way to each child. Rather, it is a set of procedures that guide our teaching and allow us to assess and shape the specific behaviors of each individual.



Skill development is fundamental to the growth of your child.

Upon entering our program, your child will be assessed so that an individualized program can be designed. Your child's program will combine the goals you identify during an in-depth intake meeting with the goals our assessment indicate are needed in order for your child to be successful. Individualized programs are monitored and revised on a regular basis in order to keep the child's progress moving to a higher level of functioning. Many of our programs have helped children to:

- Gain independence through increased self-help and daily living skills.
- Improve ability to follow single and multi-step direction with minimal or no prompting.
- Learn appropriate replacement behaviors and communication tools that reduce problematic behaviors.
- Develop social skills.
- Develop and improve pre-academic and academic skills.

Individual ABA

Individual ABA is offered to students, who need an individualized program to target skill deficits. Daytime and after-school times are available.
